

This book, illustrated with Dr. Zeus characters and poetic as were the original Dr. Zeus books, has a vocabulary far above that of the original Dr. Zeus books. I think it is more at around grade 5 reading level, and covers many inventions that at that grade level could have been developed more extensively. That is to say that part of the appeal of the original Dr. Zeus books was their easy readability and helping the child learn phonetic sounds in rather nonsensical settings, such as "I am Sam I am, and I do not like green eggs and ham." This book has none of that feel. If you want a brief introduction to many inventions, this book is a good springboard to deeper study.

This is another in the series of the Cat in The Hat science books, and we were excited to get this as our 2.5YO really enjoyed the books in this series that we had to date. Unfortunately this one just did not grip his attention the way that the others have and it has taken us a long time to get through the the book. There is a lot of good information in the book and it is presented in the expected format, but it feels like there is too much information for our LO at this timeWe are going to try this book
