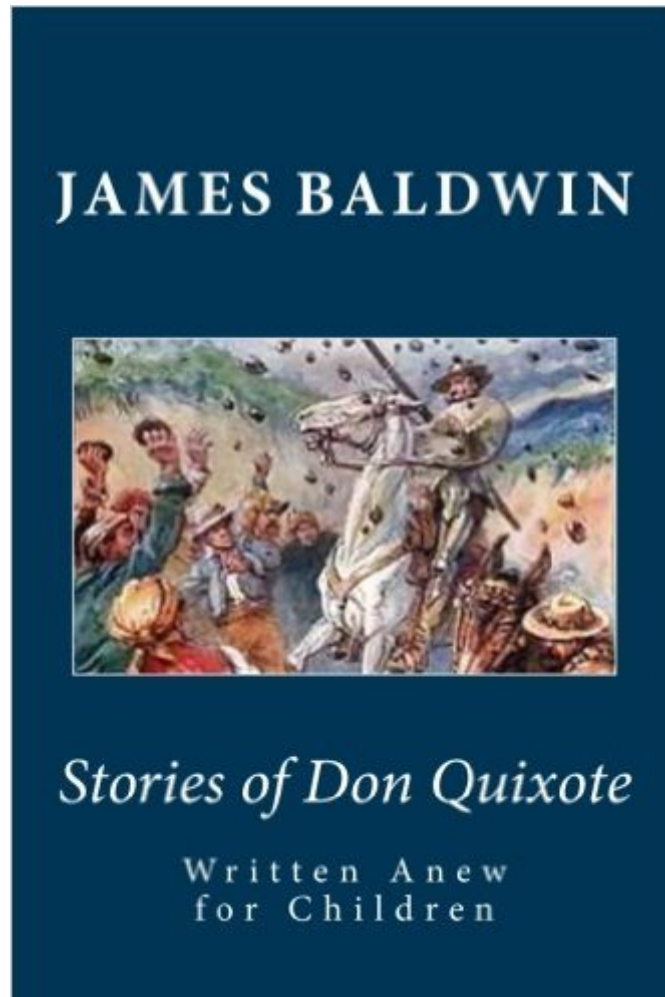

I kept looking for a children's version of Don Quixote and I think this is the best one available. There are sporadic black and white line drawings, which are helpful for following the story, and this isn't super condensed, so there's plenty of variety happening. I don't think this would work for a very young child, but overall, I was very impressed with this. I recommend it for anyone who is interested in giving your children a taste of the masterpiece without overwhelming them.

I've read Don Quixote many times while growing up in Spain, but never had I come across such an entertaining version of this wonderful novel. I bought it for my 9-year-old who absolutely loves it! It describes the characters with great detail and wit, my daughter was very engaged from beginning to end. I highly recommend it.
